LINK YOUR CUFFS TO CULTURE

Maori art continues to develop and evolve from the traditional kowhaiwhai patterns and whakairo (weaving). Many upcoming Maori designers are creating pieces that evoke a sense of culture and history, as well as producing a contemporary and essentially New Zealand piece. Shane Te Ruki has created seven pieces for New Zealand Mint, including the Pouaka (box) cufflinks. Self-taught, he has worked with a wide range of natural materials, including bone, shell and wood. His work is fully influenced by his culture. He's well-regarded as a source on Maori culture, traditional and oral history. "New life" is the theme for his cufflinks, represented by the koru.
